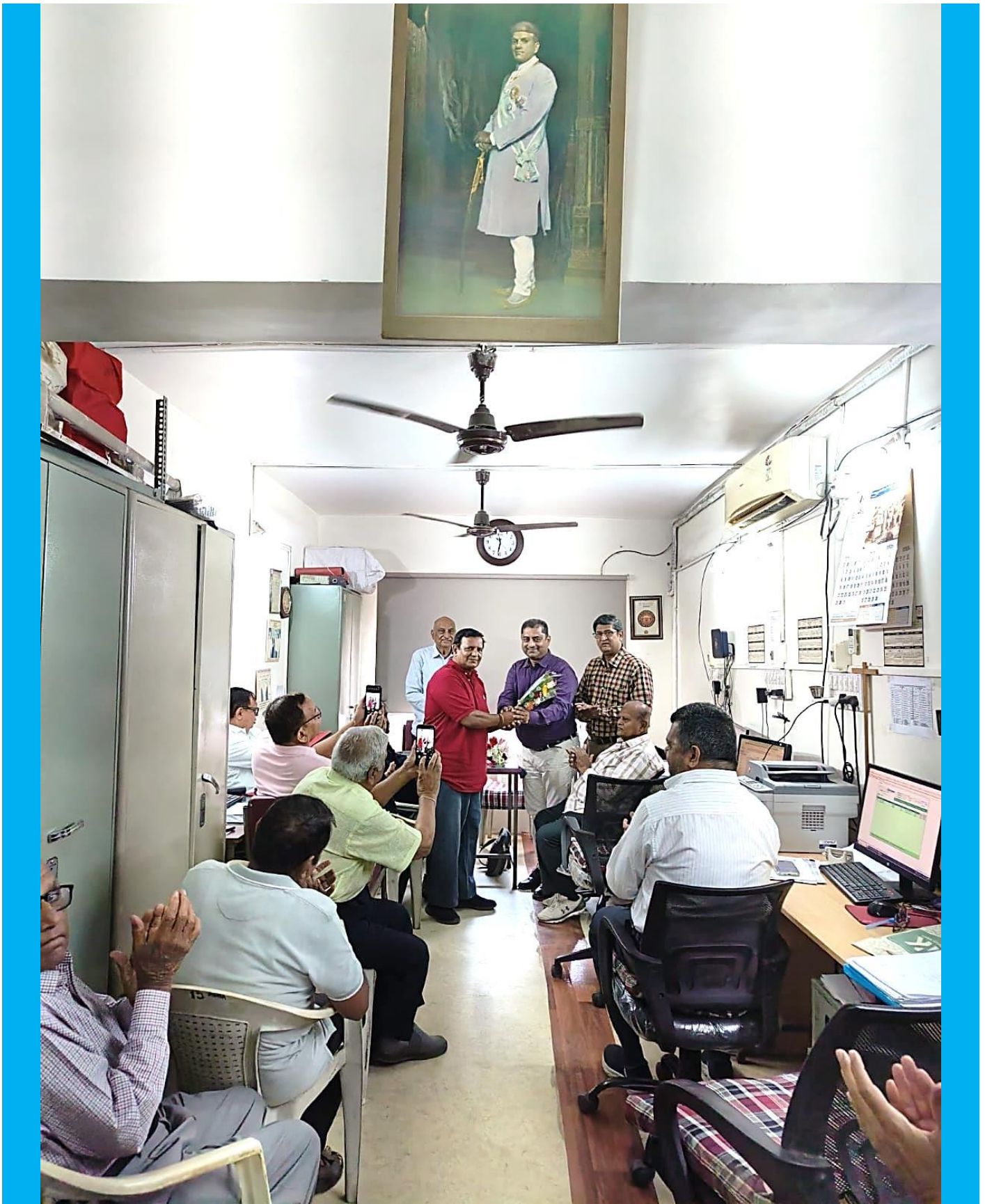

Re: Suggestions for Renewal of Group Medical Insurance Scheme for Retired Employees for the Period November 2026 to October 2027

Dear Sir,

We refer to Circular No. HO:HRPS/117/2141 dated 24.09.2025 regarding the renewal of the Group Medical Insurance Policy for retired employees under the IBA Medical Insurance Scheme 2025–26.

The policy is presently being implemented with basic insurance cover ranging from ₹3 lakh to ₹7 lakh for retired award staff and officers, along with top-up cover ranging from ₹1 lakh to ₹4 lakh. We are grateful to the Bank for renewing the policy and for providing reimbursement of ₹10,000 to ₹16,000 towards the premium paid by retired employees and surviving spouses, subject to prescribed guidelines.

As the current policy is due for renewal for the period 01.11.2026 to 31.10.2027, the Bank of Baroda Retired Officers' Association (BOBROA) wishes to submit the following suggestions for your kind consideration and for inclusion in discussions with the proposed IBA Committee.

Background

1. The Department of Financial Services (DFS), Ministry of Finance, advised the Indian Banks' Association (IBA) vide its letter dated 24.02.2012 to evolve a Medical Insurance Scheme for serving and retired bank employees.
2. The proposal was subsequently introduced by IBA as a management issue during wage revision discussions held in April–May 2015.
3. Consequently, the Group Medical Insurance Scheme was introduced for serving employees in October 2015 and for retired employees in November 2015.
4. Initially, the premium under the IBA-sponsored Group Insurance Policy was modest and affordable, resulting in encouraging participation by retirees.
5. However, the premium increased substantially over the years—from approximately ₹7,500 for a cover of ₹4 lakh to nearly ₹75,000—making the scheme unaffordable for many retirees.
6. As a result, a large number of retirees either opted out of the IBA Scheme and shifted to alternative policies or remained uninsured.
7. Many family pensioners were either unaware of the scheme or unable to afford the high premium.

8. Although our Bank provides reimbursement towards premium paid by retirees, the support presently extended is not adequate.

9. While the premium has reduced during the last two years, it continues to remain beyond the reach of many retirees and family pensioners.

Suggestions for Renewal of the Scheme

In view of the impending renewal of the policy from November 2026, we respectfully submit the following suggestions for consideration:

1. The premium for retirees should ideally be borne fully by the Bank. If this is not immediately feasible, the subsidy should be enhanced to at least 50% of the premium paid by retirees.
2. A common medical insurance policy should be maintained for both serving and retired employees to improve the claim ratio and reduce premium costs.
3. GST on insurance premiums and hospitalization expenses should be waived.
4. Physically challenged dependent children of retirees should be covered under the policy.
5. The premium for pre-1986 retirees, family pensioners, and pensioners drawing pension below ₹30,000 per month should be fully borne by the Bank.
6. Premium payable by retirees should be brought at par with that payable by serving employees.
7. Interest-free loans should be provided to retirees for payment of insurance premiums.
8. The policy period should be aligned with the wage revision settlement period.
9. Identity cards should be issued promptly and without delay.
10. Claims should be settled fully, fairly, and within a reasonable timeframe.
11. Domiciliary treatment expenses should be reimbursed in accordance with Bipartite Settlement provisions.
12. Pension for October should be credited before debiting the insurance premium from pension accounts.
13. Pandemic-related diseases should be included in the list of ailments eligible for domiciliary treatment reimbursement.
14. Retirees should be allowed to revise or change their insurance option up to the actual date of premium debit.
15. Submission of option forms through e-mail to Pension Paying Branches/Head Office should be permitted.
16. Any buffer or surplus created under the Group Insurance Policy should be utilized for the benefit of retiree subscribers.
17. More hospitals in semi-urban, urban, and metropolitan centres should be brought under tie-up arrangements with the insurer.
18. Insurance cover ranging from ₹4 lakh to ₹10 lakh in slabs of ₹1 lakh should be made available.
19. Premiums for single-person policies and top-up policies under the IBA Scheme should be substantially reduced.
20. The claim settlement process should be streamlined, and the "reasonable and customary charges" clause should be made transparent and fair.

21. Additional TPA help desks should be established to facilitate smooth claim settlement.
22. Nomination facilities should be introduced, and portability of the policy should be permitted.

We sincerely hope that the above suggestions will receive favourable consideration in the larger interest of retired employees and family pensioners. We shall be grateful if these proposals are placed before the appropriate forum for discussion and implementation.

Re: Restoration of Additional 1% Staff Rate of Interest on Deposits of Bank of Baroda Retired Officers' Association (BOBROA)

We wish to bring to your kind notice that the Bank had extended the benefit of an additional interest of 1% per annum over and above the applicable card rate on deposits maintained by our Association up to March 2019. However, the said benefit was discontinued thereafter.

The Association had submitted representations requesting restoration of the concession and has followed up the matter on several occasions. However, the benefit has not yet been restored so far. We, therefore, once again submit our request for your favourable consideration.

In support of our request, we would like to place the following facts on record:

1. Bank of Baroda Retired Officers' Association (BOBROA) was established in 1990 and is registered under the Trade Unions Act, 1926.
2. The Association presently represents more than 15,450 retired officers of the Bank across the country.
3. The financial resources of the Association are generated primarily through membership subscriptions, voluntary contributions from members & interest on deposits with our bank.
4. The Association does not receive donations, sponsorships, or advertisement revenue from external sources.
5. The funds collected from members are maintained with Bank of Baroda and, after meeting operational expenses, surplus funds are invested in term deposits with the Bank.
6. The Bank continues to extend additional interest benefits to serving employees, to associations of serving employees and retired employees.
7. We understand & reliably learnt that retired employees' associations of Canara Bank, are being extended benefit of additional interest on their deposits.

Considering the long-standing relationship between the Bank and its retired officers, and in recognition of the contribution made by retired employees towards the growth and development of the Bank, we earnestly request that the benefit of additional interest of 1% per annum over and above the Bank's applicable rate of interest on deposits maintained by BOBROA be restored.

Re: Excess Recovery of Buyback Amount under the Furniture & Fittings Scheme

We refer to our emails dated 30.01.2026 and 24.02.2026, which are yet to receive a response.

We wish to bring to your kind notice that, in some cases, the Bank has considered the representations submitted by retired officers and recalculated the buyback amount, which was found to be substantially lower than the amount originally demanded. After obtaining the consent of the concerned retired officers, the Bank recovered the recalculated amount. In a few such cases, although the Bank has recalculated the buyback amount and informed the retired officers accordingly, the refund of the excess amount recovered earlier is still awaited.

Some other retired officers have submitted representations to their respective Regional Offices (ROs) and Zonal Offices (ZOs) seeking refund of the excess buyback amount recovered from them towards furniture and fittings. They have also followed up with the ROs/ZOs. However, in many such cases, the Bank is yet to communicate its decision on their representations.

We enclose herewith a list of 35 retired officers whose representations are still pending for decision. These cases have already been taken up with the respective ROs/ZOs and were further discussed with the Chief Manager (HR), Zonal Office, and officials of the OA Department. We also discussed the pending representations pertaining to the Pune Region with the Regional Head, Pune, and the Chief Manager, OA, who assured us that the matter would be looked into.

In view of the inordinate delay in sanctioning the refund of the excess amount recovered from these retired officers, we request you to kindly consider their representations on priority and arrange to sanction the refunds at the earliest.

(BOBROA)**

We wish to draw your kind attention to our repeated requests for holding regular meetings between the Bank and the representatives of the Bank of Baroda Retired Officers' Association (BOBROA).

In this connection, we had requested the Bank, vide our letter dated 03.02.2026, to convene a meeting with the representatives of BOBROA. Thereafter, vide our Letter No. BOBROA/26/04/12 dated 24.04.2026, we once again requested for such a meeting and submitted an agenda containing various issues requiring discussion and resolution.

Subsequently, vide our Letter No. BOBROA/26/6/32 dated 05.06.2026, we reiterated our request for an early meeting, drawing attention to the relevant IBA guidelines regarding periodic interaction with retirees' associations.

However, despite our repeated representations, we are yet to receive any response from the Bank.

We, therefore, once again earnestly request you to arrange a meeting with the representatives of BOBROA at the earliest so that the issues already submitted may be discussed and resolved amicably in the interest of the retired officers and the Bank.

We also request your kind consideration of the following representations submitted to your good office:

1. Letter No. BOBROA/26/5/28 dated 25.05.2026 – Inclusion of eVRS-2001 optees under the Financial Assistance Scheme for family members/legal heirs on the demise of a retired employee.
2. Letter No. BOBROA/26/6/31 dated 05.06.2026 – Group Medical Insurance Scheme – payment of premium and subsidy.
3. Letter No. BOBROA/26/6/33 dated 05.06.2026 – Contributory Medical Assistance Scheme – enhancement of limits and coverage.
4. Letter No. BOBROA/26/6/34 dated 09.06.2026 – Restoration of the additional 1% rate of interest on deposits of the BOBROA
5. Letter No. BOBROA/26/7/2026 dated 07.07.2026 – Excess recovery of buy-back amount under the Furniture Scheme.

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Copies of the above-mentioned letters are enclosed for your ready reference.

We sincerely hope that the Bank will give due consideration to our long-pending requests and arrange an early meeting with the representatives of BOBROA so that the issues affecting retired officers can be discussed and resolved through mutual consultation.

**Re: Bank's Contributory Medical Assistance Scheme for Retired Employees
– Extension of Coverage to eVRS 2001 Retirees, Reintroduction of the Scheme
for Post-01.11.2015 Retirees, Enhancement of Medical Assistance Limit to ₹5
Lakh and Annual Domiciliary Assistance to ₹5,000**

We wish to draw your kind attention to the Bank's Contributory Medical Assistance Scheme for Retired Employees, which was introduced with effect in .2000 for employees who had already retired and those retiring thereafter.

The Scheme provided valuable medical assistance to retired employees and served as an important welfare measure. However, bank stopped inclusion of the employees retiring on or after 01.11.2015. The employees who retired up to 31.10.2015 could become members of the Scheme by contributing 50% of their last drawn Basic Pay plus Special Allowance (where applicable) which was subsequently increased to 50 % of the corresponding basic pay + stagnation increments + special allowance in Nov 2015

We would also like to highlight that officers who opted for retirement under the Bank of Baroda Employees Voluntary Retirement Scheme (BOBEVRS) 2001 were not permitted to become members of the Scheme. Several such retirees submitted applications seeking membership, but their requests were returned with the remark that they were not covered under the Scheme. Despite repeated representations made by eVRS 2001 retirees up to the year 2015, the Bank continued to reject their applications. We the BOBROA also represented to the bank for consideration of eVRS 2001 eligible under the scheme, however bank did not consider it favourably

We are of the considered view that the benefits of the Contributory Medical Assistance Scheme should be extended to eVRS 2001 retirees, particularly after they attain the age of 60 years at least subject to their making the prescribed contribution and fulfilling other eligibility conditions.

Further, the discontinuation of the Scheme for employees retiring on or after 01.11.2015 has deprived a large number of retirees of an important post-retirement medical support mechanism. Considering the steep rise in medical treatment costs and the increasing burden of medical insurance premiums, many retirees find it difficult to meet healthcare expenses despite reimbursement support provided by the Bank under the Group Medical Insurance Scheme.

In view of the above, we request the Bank to review the Scheme and consider the following:
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1. Extend the benefits of the Contributory Medical Assistance Scheme to retirees covered under BOBEVRS 2001.
2. Extend the Scheme for employees who retired on or after 01.11.2015 and permit them to become members on payment of the prescribed contribution.
3. Enhance the ceiling of medical assistance under the Scheme from the existing level to ₹5 lakh.
4. Increase the annual limit for domiciliary medical expenses to ₹5,000.
5. Include reimbursement of dental treatment expenses under the Scheme, as dental ailments often lead to serious health complications and significantly affect the overall health of senior citizens.

We would also like to bring to your notice certain operational issues being faced by existing members. Earlier, subscribers were issued passbooks containing records of hospitalization claims and reimbursements. The system has now been migrated to HRConnect. However, some retirees have reported inconsistencies in the data available on the portal, including:

- Non-availability of hospitalization claim history.
- Inability to lodge claims through the system.
- Incorrect display of ineligibility for domiciliary claims.
- Incomplete or inaccurate member records.

We request that the HRConnect platform be suitably updated and streamlined to ensure accurate records and seamless claim processing for retired employees.

We sincerely believe that a review of the Scheme in the above lines will provide much-needed relief to retired employees and family pensioners and reinforce the Bank's commitment towards the welfare of its retirees.

We shall be grateful for your favourable consideration of our request.

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STATUS OF LEGAL ISSUES AS OF 11-Jul-2026

1. UPDATION OF PENSION.

SPECIAL CIVIL APPLICATION (WRIT) R/SCA 4258/2019 BOBROA VERSUS BOB AND ORS. BEFORE HON'BLE GUJARAT HIGH COURT, AHMEDABAD.

We have filed a petition in Gujarat High Court in 2019 seeking updation of Pension for our members. Though the case is getting listed on the website of the High Court, the hearing is not taking place.

The issues raised in this petition are similar to that of the case of Late M C Singla which is pending at Supreme Court. Hence we shall await the outcome of the said case at SC level.

As we all know, at Supreme Court, the Singla case was heard on Feb5, 2026 wherein the advocates have given their submission for updation of pension. The Court had directed both the sides to provide a statement showing the implementation of the Pension Regulations. The next hearing is on 22-july-2026. AIBPARC, to which we are affiliated is providing all the support for this case.

In the meantime, SC had placed the case for Arbitration, which has not been acceded to by the Petitioner and AIBPARC. Hence we need to await for the proceedings in the Court at next hearing.

2. INCLUSION OF SPECIAL ALLOWANCE (W.E.F.1.11.2012)

IN THE PENSIONARY BENEFIT IN VIEW OF JOINT NOTE DATED 25.5.2015

WP(c) 35691/2019 titled as A.V. Jose & 7 Ors. V/s Bank of Baroda & Ors. before Hon'ble Kerala High Court at Ernakulum.

BOBROA had impleaded into the case, which is pending at the Division Bench. The case is tagged with the erstwhile Corporation Bank case where that Bank had appealed against the order of the Single Judge granting the relief to the pensioners.

IBA had filed a Transfer Petition (Civil) No. 1394/2023 before the Supreme Court and the Hon'ble Court had allowed the transfer of all pending cases to a single HC vide their order dated 4-july-2023. The Court had noted that the first case was in Delhi HC and had kept all other cases in abeyance.

Latest Development ::

IBA have included the petitioners of Erstwhile Corporation Bank in WP(C) 32386 of 2015 as Respondents in the transfer petition case. However, IBA did not disclosed that the said case has been already disposed of and that an Appeal is pending before the Division Bench of HC of Kerala. Our Advocate has engaged a Senior Lawyer to present the matter before the Supreme Court. The transfer petition of IBA is still pending at SC.

The SC in its order dated 4-july-2023 had interalia passed an order ".....in similar cases pending in the other High Courts be kept in abeyance, until the returnable date."

In view of the Transfer order by Supreme Court, the Appeal case in Kerala High Court is pending for further dates.

3. ADDITIONAL GRATUITY –

For those who were granted ARB.

Writ Petition titled as Bank of Baroda Retired Officers' Association versus Bank of Baroda stands filed on 6.5.2022 with filing No. SCA/9471/2022. Gujarat High Court, Ahmedabad.

The petition had been filed in the Court and due to Covid situation the case hasn't come up for listing for long time.

Bank had filed its response to the petition and we have given our brief to the advocate to file our rejoinder. We have briefed our advocate appropriately to defend our case. We have also advised our advocate to file for an early hearing of the case.

In the meanwhile, as per a Appellate Authority's order in Karnataka, we have reliably come to know that the Bank has paid ARB to a retired employee in addition to the Additional Gratuity under BOB(O)SR. This matter has also been informed to our advocate to be placed to the Court.

The next date of the hearing is awaited.

4. SHORT GRATUITY PAYMENT MATTERS

– M C Josekutty & Ors Vs RLC & Ors. WP(C) 31973/2023, Kerala High Court

As decided in Varanasi meeting, details of claims made by members at various zones were collected and issues raised were collated. Special attention was given to the issues raised in Kerala. It was also decided that BOBROA will file ONE case and support the individuals connected to that case for filing the petitions.

In 7 claims filed by members, the Controlling Authority granted reliefs prayed. Bank filed an appeal before the Appellate Authority at Ernakulam who dismissed the order passed by the Controlling Authority.

A Writ petition was filed by M C Josekutty & Ors before the Kerala High Court which was admitted. Later on, BOBROA has impleaded in the case which has been allowed. Case yet to come up for hearing after 11-dec-2023.

5. Gratuity matters

WP (c) 30684 of 2024 – T L Davis & Ors Vs BOB at Kerala High Court

BOBROA has filed this petition regarding non-payment of Gratuity beyond 30 years by Bank of Baroda in contravention of the Gratuity Rules. BOBROA is listed as 32nd petitioner in the case along with 31 members of the Association belonging to Kerala.

The main issues raised in the petition are

- Payment of Gratuity @ 45 days for every year of service beyond 30 years
- Addition of Dearness Allowance under BOB(O)SR, 1979
- To compute the daily salary by dividing the monthly salary by 26 for calculating Gratuity
- Seeks direction to the respondent Bank to pay the differential gratuity to petitioners and members of the Organisation

Next date awaited.

6. GST on Medical Insurance

Govt of India announced that GST on medical insurance was abolished. However, National Insurance Company while renewing the IBA Medical insurance policy levied GST. AIBPARC gave advisory that individual affiliates may take a call at their end. BOBROA therefore filed a petition in Kerala HC which was subsequently tagged with WP(C) NO. 38552 OF 2025 by AIBPARC. Initially a Stay was granted and our Policy was renewed without GST. The Highcourt later ruled against us and permitted levying GST on the IBA Policy as it was a Group insurance Policy and GST exemption was granted only to individual policies.

AIBPARC had filed an appeal in the High Court which was pleased to stay the order of the single judge.WA 76/2026

The arguments in the case have been completed. The Counsel for GST had sought time to place on record some documents which the court has accepted. The Counsel for GST was directed by the Court to submit the recommendations based on which the GST on Medical insurance was decided. Posted for 15-july-2026.

The Stay granted continues till date

Other important legal developments ::

- Commutation case decided by Delhi HC WP 12781/2024

A bunch of cases were clubbed by the Delhi HC and decided the matter regarding Restoration of Commuted amount after 15 years. The Court upheld the rule of 15 years and refrained from granting any relief.

CONCLUSION:

75. For the reasons recorded in the preceding discussion, this Court finds that the challenge to Rule 10-A of the CCS Commutation Rules and analogous provisions governing other pension regimes is devoid of merit. The prescription of a uniform fifteen-year period for restoration of the commuted portion of pension represents a conscious policy determination founded upon actuarial evaluation, expert recommendations and long-standing statutory practice, and does not suffer from any constitutional infirmity warranting interference in exercise of writ jurisdiction.

77. All remaining writ petitions filed by the Pensioner-Petitioners assailing Rule 10-A of the CCS Commutation Rules and analogous provisions applicable to Railway, Defence, Banks and other pension establishments are dismissed. The validity of the uniform fifteen-year restoration period for commuted pension is upheld.

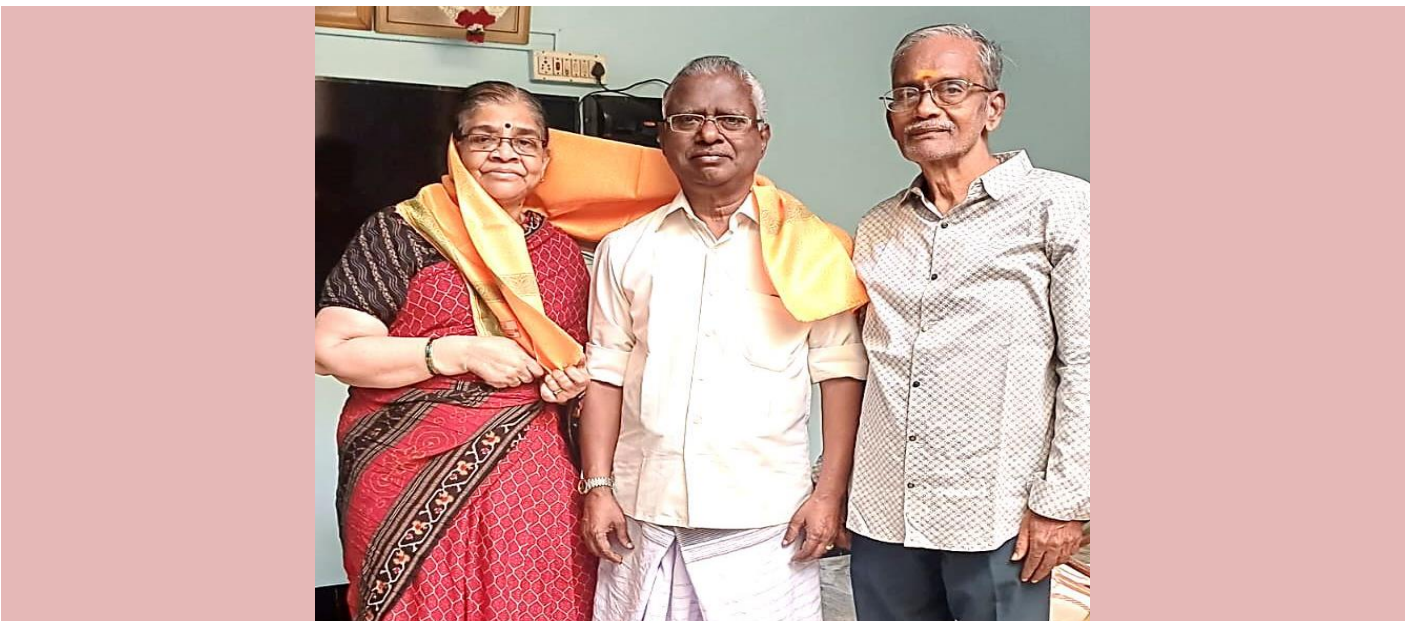

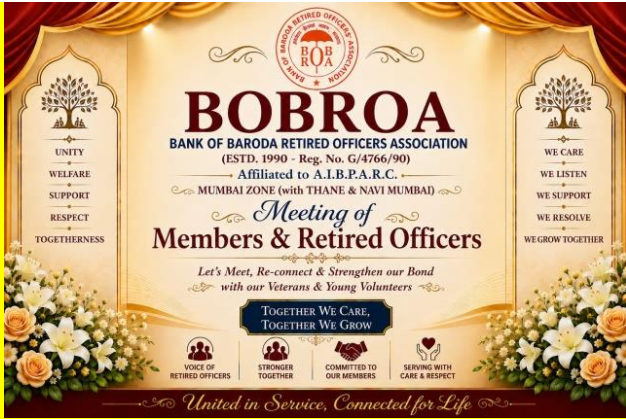
C) JUNE, 2026:

ACTIVITIES REPORT FOR THE QUARTER ENDED JUNE 2026

The Zone enrolled -7- new members during the quarter, taking the total active membership to 1,438, comprising 1,380 Bank of Baroda retirees, 58 erstwhile Dena/Vijaya Bank retirees, including 290 family pensioners. The Membership mobilization continues to receive focused attention across all centers

The Members responded enthusiastically to the appeal for donations and special contributions. During the quarter, 378 members contributed ₹ 6,30,920, reflecting their continued faith in and commitment to the Association. The entire amount has been remitted to the Central Office.

The Kolhapur Unit conducted its Annual General Meeting on 21 April 2026, attended by over 50 members from Kolhapur and Sangli. Shri V. B. Chavan, General Secretary, briefed the members on the Association's initiatives relating to pension anomalies, Group Medical Insurance, furniture buy-back issues and other matters affecting retirees. Members completing 75 years of age were felicitated. Senior Bank officials, including the AGM and DRM, attended the meeting and assured continued support in resolving retirees' issues.

The Pune Zone Annual General Body Meeting was held on 12 June 2026 under the chairmanship of Shri P. D. Potnis, former General Manager, Bank of Baroda and former Banking Ombudsman. Shri Rajesh Kumar, General Manager & Zonal Head, attended as Chief Guest, while Shri Rajan Kumar, Regional Head, Pune City Region, Shri P. S. Patki, Working President, AIBPARC, and Shri Vaibhav Patil, Zonal Secretary, AIBOBOA, were the Special Invitees. More than 185 members participated in the programme. Twenty-one members who completed 75 years of age were felicitated with silver mementoes. The General Body also adopted a special resolution appreciating the outstanding services and leadership of Shri V. B. Chavan on his unanimous election as General Secretary of BOBROA.



A members' meeting was successfully organized at Satara on 21 May 2026, attended by around 40 members. Family pension issues, PPO verification and other retirees' grievances were discussed in detail. Shri V. B. Chavan was felicitated by the Satara members on his election as General Secretary.



Several online and physical meetings of the Zonal Committee, Insurance Committee and activists were held during the quarter. The Zone unanimously elected Shri Ram Kamble as Zonal Secretary and Shri S. V. Chavan as Assistant Zonal Secretary. The General Secretary regularly updated members on organizational developments, deliberations of the AIBPARC Governing Council and General Body, pension updation, medical insurance, pending court cases and other important retirees' issues.

The Zone actively recognized senior members and maintained close liaison with Bank authorities. Units at Jalgaon, Nashik, Aurangabad and Goa felicitated members and senior executives on important occasions.

The Goa Unit successfully pursued the empanelment of six additional hospitals under the IBA Group Health Insurance Scheme, significantly improving cashless medical facilities for retirees in the State.

The Zone also maintained regular interaction with Zonal and Regional Offices, continued publication of its quarterly e-bulletin "Spandan".

The Pune Zone places on record its sincere appreciation to all office bearers, committee members, activists and members for their wholehearted support. The Zone also gratefully acknowledges the guidance and encouragement received from the Central Leadership, which enabled the successful implementation of its programs and activities during the quarter.
